It will be the first building in Poland to have its own, customised audiosphere that will create unique ambience and adjust to the pace and rhythm of life inside in real time. It has been designed by Wojciech Urbański, a renowned Polish composer, producer and sound designer. In addition to composing the music, he has designed a whole package of acoustic and visual experiences for the tenants and visitors of VIBE.

VIBE is being built in compliance with Ghelamco's ESG strategy. The property will use an ultramodern Building Energy Management System (BEMS) that will help significantly reduce energy consumption. The sustainable nature of the project will be certified to WELL, BREEAM, DGNB, SmartScore, WiredScore and Green Building Standard. As regards the first two standards, the developer aims at the highest possible certification levels: Platinum and Outstanding. The office building will ultimately be powered by 100% clean energy.

Like other Ghelamco properties, VIBE will be equipped with the proprietary Signal OS, which monitors the building's condition and ensures the optimum working environment. Anti-pandemic solutions, such as UV disinfection lamps in lifts and ventilation systems, will look after user well-being and comfort.

In an effort to encourage ecological means of transport, VIBE will offer extensive infrastructure for cyclists (such as cabinets, showers, bike parking, repair station) as well as charges for electric cars and two-wheel vehicles. The building's excellent location near the Rondo Daszyńskiego metro station, tramway stations as well as Warszawa Główna and Ochota railway stations will encourage the use of public transport.
